Pramhans Shri Sant Shankar Maharaj received blessings from Gurudev Paramhans Lahanuji Maharaj, Takarkheda and Paramhans Shri Satyadev Baba, Bharvadi.

Shri Sant Shankar Maharaj Ashram Trust is having various temples and bhaktidham in its surroundings. But also everyday thousands of devotees from different parts of Maharashtra and India visit the Ashram and take blessings of Shri Sant Shankar Maharaj. Ashram provides lodging, boarding and Mahaprasad facilities to the visitors free of charge.

The Ashram owns more than 200 acres of land. On this land, different crops are being cultivated. This land is facilitated with advanced irrigation techniques (sprinkler, drip irrigation, fertigation), and modern farm machineries (JCB, tractors, rotavator, cultivator, harvester and others). Admission Criteria & Process

The age of the candidate should be 16 years as on the last date of submission of application. Candidates must have passed the qualifying examination (12th Std. Science) with minimum 50% marks for General category (Open) and minimum 40% marks in aggregate for reserved categories (SC/ST/VJa/NTb/NTc/NTd / OBC / SBC/EWS/PH).

Admission in universities or institutes offering B.Sc. in Agriculture course is done based on the Common Entrance Test conducted by the competent authority (MHTCET/JEE/NEET), the merit of admission will be determined by considering total percentile marks obtained in the respective group (PCB / PCM) & other weightages.

The changes will be made in admission eligibility and admission process as per government resolution issued time to time. The details on how to apply for B.Sc. degree in Agriculture can be collected from the authorized website. Annual fees as per Declared by FRA Year by Year.

B. Sc (Hons.) Agriculture course

B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture involves the study of agriculture sciences and use of modern scientific equipment and techniques in agriculture, land surveying, soil science, water resource management, animal and poultry management, basics of biotechnology etc. The objective of the course is to use these concepts to train students to improve agricultural productivity. B.Sc. Agriculture syllabus includes subjects such as Agronomy, Horticulture, Plant Biochemistry, Water Management Engineering, Study of Pests of Crops, amongst others. The syllabus is designed to provide an overall knowledge of agriculture and all its related disciplines.

1) Agronomy: Basics of Agronomy, Field Crops (Kharif), Field Crops (Rabi), Crop Production, Weed Management, Irrigation Techniques, Water Resource Management, Organic Farming, Sustainable Agriculture. Apart from theoretical subjects, practical sessions are also involved in case of these subjects.

2) Plant Genetics: Botany, Basics of Genetics, Plant Breeding, Seed Technology, Basics of Biotechnology. Apart from the above mentioned theoretical subjects, practical sessions involving these subjects are also present.

3) Soil Science: Introduction to Soil Science, Soil Fertility, Soil Chemistry, Fertilizers, Agricultural Chemistry. Apart from the above mentioned theoretical subjects, practical sessions involving the subjects are also present.

4) Entomology: Pest Management, Beneficial Insects, Grain Storage and Management. Like the above entries, along with theoretical subjects, practical sessions involving them are also present.

5) Plant Pathology: Crop Diseases, Practical sessions related to the theoretical subjects are also present.

6) Horticulture: Fruit and Vegetable Crops, Medicinal Plants, Aromatic Plants, Flower Production, Spices, Plantation Crops. Practical sessions related to the theoretical subjects are also present.

7) Agricultural Economics: Market prices, Trade prices, Marketing, Finance, Agribusiness Management, Farm Management. Along with the theoretical subjects, practical sessions involving them are also present.

8) Agricultural Extension : Dimensions of Agricultural Extension, Extension Methodologies, Entrepreneurship Development program. Practical sessions related to the theoretical subjects is also present. Biochemistry, Physiology, Microbiology Computer Education, English, Physical Education, Animal Product etc.

9) Agriculture Engineering: Agriculture Machinery, Power and Tools, Harvest Technology, Environment Science and Engineering, Renewable Energy. Along with the theoretical subjects, practical sessions involving them are also present.

10) Skill enhancement Courses (SEC): Students admitted into 1st year to 3rd year of B.Sc. (Hons) Agriculture degree programme, The skill enhancement course is compulsory and that will be benefited strengthening and expertise in the entrepreneurship.

11) Agricultural Meteorology: Climate patterns, Climatic hazards on Agriculture, Climatic Zones, Weather forecasting. Practical sessions related to the theoretical subjects are also present.

12) Career Prospects : B.Sc. (Honours) Agriculture is considered a professional degree. The graduates from this degree can find jobs in both public and private sectors. The importance of agriculture is growing rapidly and thereby is increasing the job prospects in the field of agriculture. Today Graduates with B.Sc. Agriculture are readily absorbed in government projects, Agricultural departments, Extension services, Research organizations, Commercial farming etc.

Prohibition of Ragging Act

According to Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act No. 33, 15th May, 1999, ragging is strictly prohibited in the campus. Ragging means a display of disorderly conduct, the doing of any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise the apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment in a student in any educational institutes and includes-

- i. Teasing, abusing, threatening or playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to any student or
- ii. Asking a student to do any act or to perform something which a student will not in the ordinary course, willing do. Ragging within or outside of any educational institute is prohibited.

Penalty for ragging : Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees

Dismissal of student : Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.

Attendance

1. (A) Every student shall attend all lectures, practicals, library work, extension education visits, study tour and the meeting with teacher, counselor, etc. The minimum requirement of attendance will be 80% However, under exceptional circumstances and on application of the student, the Associate Dean/Principal may exempt the student from attending the study tours or other events organized or allowed to participate officially as college/University representative.
(B) Student registered for "Student READY" programme shall have minimum 85% attendance.
2. The student who fails to attend the compulsory study tour will have to complete it during the next year as and when conducted.
3. Each teacher shall maintain a record of students attendance in a register for each course taught/or deemed to have been taught in semester due to mass absents by him in a semester.
4. If a student's fails to attend 80% (eighty per cent) of the total number of lectures, practical in a laboratory or field, tutorial classes in a course in a held and deemed to have been held during a semester, irrespective of his date of registration, he shall not be eligible to appear at the semester-end examination and shall be awarded Non Registered (NR) grade. Such a student shall repeat the course when offered by registering as a regular student.
5. The Associate Dean/Principal may condone the shortage of attendance up to a maximum of 15% of the total on valid reasons. A student participating in inter-collegiate and higher level tournaments/activities sponsored by the University should be deemed to have attended the classes during such period on recommendation of Associate Dean/Principal of the college.

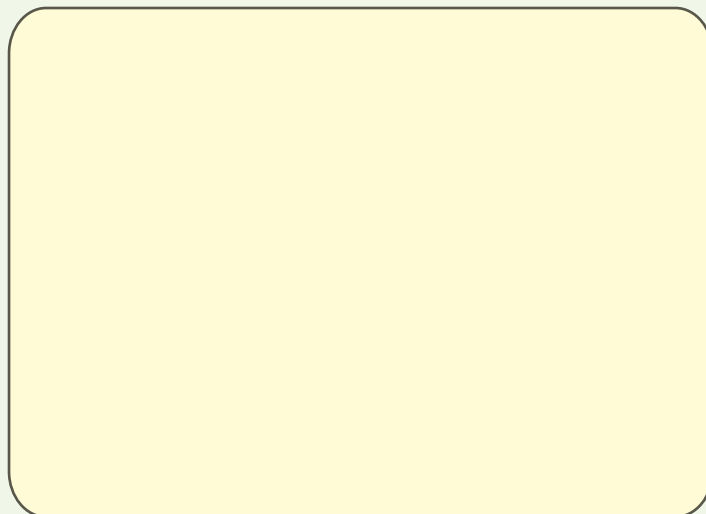

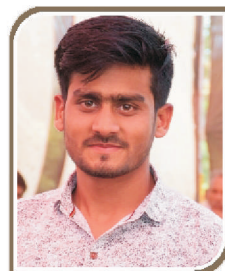

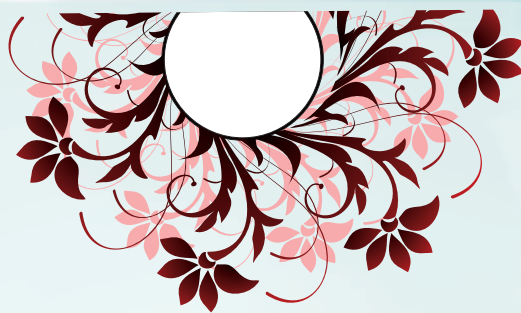
